

Grant Sponsored Free Toddler Swimming Lessons!

SNC-ICC Gives Town \$1,500.00.

In October 2009, the Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council (SNC-ICC) presented the Town Park & recreation Department a \$1,500.00 grant to provide free swimming lessons for toddlers four years old and younger. Their membership saw this as an important investment to help reduce the number of drowning deaths throughout southern Nevada.

During the last three years, 26 toddlers' lives were lost due to drowning deaths in swimming pools in Southern Nevada. The SNC-ICC members believe it is time to do whatever can be done to reduce future occurrences of such drowning deaths and recognize that teaching toddlers to swim is one of the best ways to reduce such occurrences.

In support of their concern, SNC-ICC provided the Southern Nevada Cities/Towns a \$1,500.00 grant to their Parks & Recreation Departments to provide free swimming lessons to toddlers 4 years and younger.

The Town of Pahrump contributed advertising funding to let citizens know about the availability. Fifty children were registered and completed lessons. The ages ranged from 1 to 5 years of age.

Please let your family, friends and neighbors know about this program, because we have been very

Proposed Pahrump Valley Airport – The Town of Pahrump in conjunction with the FAA attended and participated in the EIS Consultant interviews. These interviews took place on Tuesday, July 13, 2010 in Burlingame, CA. Three consulting firms were interviewed. After the background checks have been completed, a consulting firm will be chosen. This process should take between two and four weeks. Then the next step in the process is to sit down with that consulting firm and negotiate a contract between the firm and the Town of Pahrump. If all speculations are true, the Town of Pahrump should have an airport up and running by the end of November 2015.

Last Chance Park – The Town of Pahrump has recently spoken with an archeologist about the costs and time span for mitigating the prehistoric lithic scatter which was found by a BLM archeologist. The Town should have more detail on this process this week. It appears that the price tag for the mitigation is between \$3,000.00 and \$12,000.00 depending on the size of the finding.

Simkins Park – The “Notice to Proceed” letter has been sent to the construction firm. Construction will finally start within two weeks. YEA!

Ian Deutch Memorial Park – The boulders with the Park’s name will be completed within the next three weeks. The Town is in the process of setting up a ceremony for official re-naming and unveiling of the boulders. More updated details will be released through the media outlets within the Town of Pahrump so that all of the citizens of Pahrump can attend.

Town Website – On Saturday, July 02, 2010 the Town’s new website (www.pahrumpnv.org) was officially launched. The site contains detailed information on the Town and its inner-workings. The site consists of: Photo of the Week, In the Spotlight, Quick Links, Pahrump Weather, and all the boring stuff that we call Town of Pahrump Local Government happenings/business.
