

PAHRUMP TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING PTO NO. 39, WHICH ESTABLISHED A UNIFORM POLICY REGARDING MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE TOWN CEMETERY; A SHORT TITLE; DEFINITION; PLOTS; LINERS REQUIRED; BURIAL PERMITS REQUIRED; GRAVE DIGGING AND SETTING OF HEADSTONES; DUTIES OF THE SEXTON; INDIGENT BURIALS; MISCELLANEOUS REGULATIONS; FEES; GENERAL VIOLATION; PENALTIES THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, on or about the 1st day of May, 1992, Nye County quitclaimed land, APN Nos. 38-271-13 and 38-271-15 to the Unincorporated Town of Pahrump for the purpose of operating a public cemetery.

WHEREAS, the Town subsequently passed PTO No. 39, which established a uniform policy regarding management and maintenance of the Town cemetery.

WHEREAS, the Town no longer desires to operate a public cemetery. According to the Quitclaim Deed, if the land ceases to be used for a public cemetery, the land shall automatically revert to Nye County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, does hereby ordain as follows:

50.000. DISCONTINUANCE. The Town will no longer operate a public cemetery on the aforementioned land which was conveyed to the Town by Nye County for that purpose.

50.100. REPEAL OF PTO NO. 39. The Unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nevada hereby repeals PTO No. 39 in its entirety.

50.200. DOCUMENTS. The Town shall immediately execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the transfer of land to Nye County.

50.300. REPEAL. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or chapters, sections, or paragraphs or resolutions previously adopted by the Pahrump Town Board which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

50.400. SEVERABILITY. Every section of this Ordinance and Amendment, and every part of every section hereof is hereby declared to be independent of every other section and part of section. The holding of any section or part of section void does not affect the validity of any other section or part.

50.500. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption, and second publication in a newspaper printed and published within the Town

of Pahrump, County of Nye, State of Nevada.
