Title: FIREWORKS (BILL NO. 80-3, ORDINANCE NO. 9)

Description: AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF
FIREWORKS IN THE AREA COMMONLY KNOWN AS
THE "PAHRUMP COMMUNITY PARK"; AND TO
PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Nye County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Trustees of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada, does hereby ordain as follows:

9.010 FIREWORKS AREA RESTRICTION.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep, use or otherwise exhibit "fireworks" within the grounds commonly known as the "Pahrump Community Park," or within any building located thereon, or any other public park or public building located within the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada.

9.020 SALE OF FIREWORKS

The sale of "fireworks" shall be limited to the period in which the community is to celebrate the anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Sales shall be limited to the period so designated by the Board of Nye County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Trustees of the unincorporated Town of Pahrump, Nye County, Nevada.

9.030 PENALTY

All persons guilty of having willfully or deliberately violated any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

9.040 EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication for a period of one week, or two successive issues, in the Tonopah Times-Bonanza, a newspaper printed and published within the County of Nye, State of Nevada, to-wit, after August 21, 1980.
